PREFACE

West Bengal Right to Public Services Act, 2013 is an important legislation in the field of delivery of services to the citizen. The right of the citizen has been put first through mechanism charted in the Act, and Rules made thereunder for clear identification of the services, authorities responsible for delivering such services within the bureaucratic hierarchy, and accountability of its different layers.

The Consumer Affairs Department decided to publish a Handbook on the West Bengal Right to Public Services Act, 2013 for benefit of all concerned. Apart from the Act, Rules and enabling notifications issued by the respective service providing departments, it contains a short write up on the salient features of the legislation and frequently asked questions (FAQ). As the number of services brought under the purview of the Act is bound to increase with passage of time, we hope to bring out a new edition soon.
